Date	Description
September 7	The LA BOSCO publishes its FY 2021 CoC Program local competition Request for Proposals (RFP) and associated documents at https://laboscoc.org/fy21-coc-program-competition and via its email distribution list
September 10	The LA BOSCO hosts an informational webinar about the CoC Program and applying to the local competition’s RFP; registration details will be published to the LA BOSCO’s website and via the LA BOSCO’s email distribution list
September 13	All supplemental documents related to the FY 2021 CoC Program local competition will be released by this date, including the Renewal Project Scoring Tool and New Project Scoring Tool (estimated)
October 22	PROJECT APPLICATIONS DUE: all new and renewal project applications must be submitted to glevine@lhc.la.gov by 4 PM CST
November 5	The LA BOSCO notifies all new and renewal project applications whether their projects were conditionally funded as written, conditionally funded at a reduced rate, or rejected

Date	Description
November 8	Deadline for project applicants to submit appeals to the LA BOSCO Board
November 10	Deadline for LA BOSCO Board to respond to any appeals
November 11	The LA BOSCO Board responds to all appeals and notifies all new and renewal project applications whether their projects will be submitted as part of the consolidated application as written, submitted at a reduced rate, or not submitted
November 17	PROJECT APPLICATIONS MUST BE FINALIZED IN E-SNAPS: all new and renewal project applications conditionally approved for funding must be submitted to HUD in e-snaps by 4 PM CST
November 22	The LA BOSCO publishes the draft consolidated application and project priority listing for public comment at www.laboscoc.org
November 24	The LA BOSCO publishes the finalized consolidated application and project priority listing and submits them to HUD (estimated)
December 16	Final date on which the LA BOSCO can submit the finalized consolidated application and project priority listing to HUD
